Nomination for Distinguished
Deadline: July 31st of each calendar year

The Society for Public Health Education is accepting nominations for its Distinguished Fellow Award. This award recognize persons whose contributions to the field of health education or public health entitles them to SOPHE's highest form of recognition. The award will be presented at the SOPHE Annual Meeting Awards Banquet on Saturday, November 3, in Washington, DC.

CRITERIA

The Distinguished Fellow Award recognizes individuals who have made significant and lasting contributions to SOPHE and to the profession of health education.

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

Submit the following materials by July 31st of each calendar year:

1. A nomination form and cover letter by a SOPHE member in good standing who will coordinate the nomination process and present the award at the Annual Meeting;
2. A recent curriculum vitae of the nominee;
3. Letters of support from 7 additional SOPHE members.

Required Elements for Nomination and Support Letters:

Letters of support should provide the following evidence, examples, documentation, and/or information about the nominee.

1. Significant contributions to health education;
2. The creative or exceptional nature of these contributions;
3. Professional recognition (honors, awards, special appointments, offices held, research, writing, etc.);
4. The results and impact of the nominee's work;
5. Leadership within SOPHE;
6. The continuing worth of the nominee's contribution to health education, SOPHE, and public health.

Note: Awards are recommended by the SOPHE Awards Committee and approved by the Board of Trustees.

Nominations and support letters are due in the SOPHE National Office by July 31st of each calendar year.
