**CRITERIA:**

- Nominator and mentor nominee must be National SOPHE Members.(Membership status can be verified through the National SOPHE office, 202/408-9804)
- Evidence of fostering the bridge linking research and practice.
- Impact of mentoring on an individual's (or individuals') professional development.
- Implementation of creative strategies for the mentoring process.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR NOMINATIONS:**

- Nomination Form.
- Nomination letter describing:
  - a) how the nominee has mentored an individual or individuals, and
  - b) how the nominee meets the eligibility criteria for the award.
- Letters of Support (maximum of five) speaking to the mentoring qualities of the nominee.
- Recent Curriculum Vitae or Resume for the mentor nominee.

**Note:** Awards are recommended by the SOPHE Awards Committee and approved by the Board of Trustees.
