Definition of chronically homeless: someone who is either (1) an unaccompanied homeless individual with a disabling condition who has been continuously homeless for a year or more, OR (2) an unaccompanied individual with a disabling condition who has had at least four episodes of homelessness in the past three years.”

The demographic information from the presentation is taken from the 2009 Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR) which uses point in time (PIT) count data that is entered annually, however, that PIT data could be based on an annual or biennial count depending upon the CoC.
